# Pocket Posh Tips for Quilters Jodie Davis and Jayne Davis

Save time, thread, and energy by chain piecing. Feed the patches to be joined together through the machine, one right after the other, without ever lifting the pressure foot. Leave just enough room separating each pair so they can be cut apart later as needed.

**Personal experience**: I have just used this method on a quilt and found it so time saving. Keep your stitch ripper at the ready. SB

## **DUTIES OF OFFICERS FOR DECEMBER ELECTION**

### **ARTICLE 4 – DUTIES OF OFFICERS**

#### 4.1 PRESIDENT

- i. Prepare agenda and chair the meetings of the members and Executive Committee.
- ii. Call Executive Committee meetings as required.
- iii. Collect mail and distribute it as needed.
- iv. Carry out NMQG business as directed by the membership and in collaboration with the Executive Committee.
- v. Support members of the Executive Committee in their individual roles.
- vi. Act as the NMQG contact to other quilting organizations and the general public.
- vii. Forward NMQG related information to the membership; and
- viii. Place liability and property insurance for NMQG.

#### **4.2 VICE-PRESIDENT**

- i. Assume the duties of the President in the absence of the President.
- ii. Maintain a current list of active members and submit to Modern Quilt Guild.
- iii. Distribute membership list to members and coordinate with the Treasurer to promote membership.
- iv. Communicate NMQG information by e-mail to members, and
- v. Administer NMQG Zoom account.

#### **4.3 TREASURER**

- i. With the assistance of the Executive Committee, establish an annual budget for the Niagara Modern Quilt Guild.
- ii. Collect annual dues from members and coordinate membership needs with the Vice President.
- iii. Maintain financial records of NMQG and report to the Executive Committee and membership as required.
- iv. Receive and promptly pay authorized accounts, undertake banking for NMQG (receive payments, make deposits, write cheques, arrange for update of signing authorities), and manage assets; and
- v. Prepare the annual financial statements at the end of the fiscal year.
